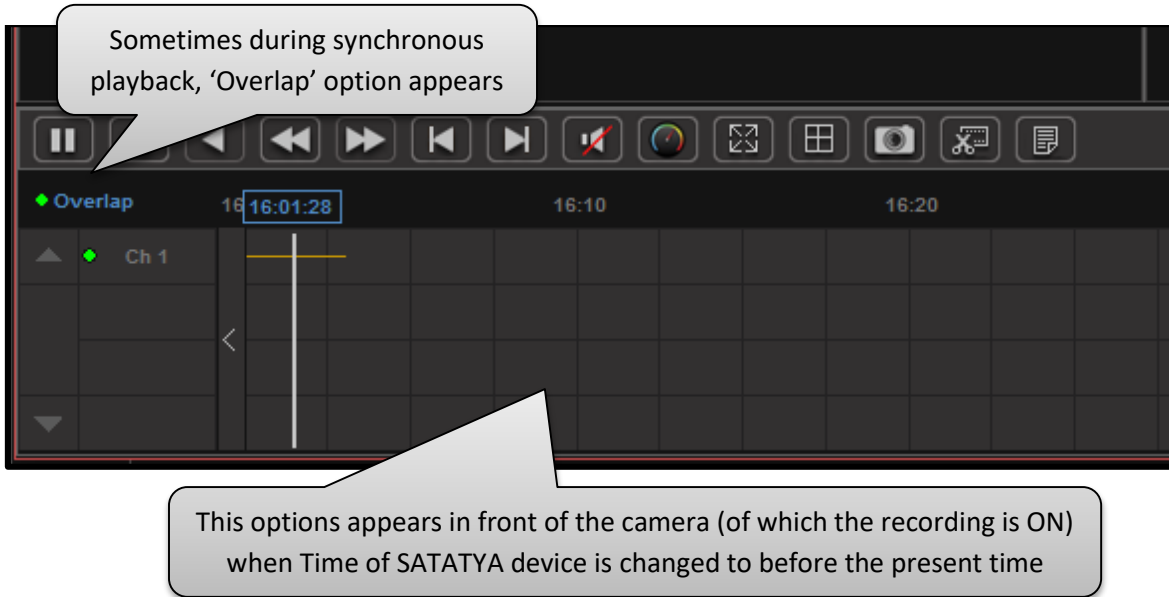

## What does 'Overlap' option in Synchronous Playback of SATATYA devices mean?



Date and Time of the device can be changed because of the following reasons:

1. Whenever RTC of the device gets updated or
2. When someone manually changes the Date and Time of the device.

Let us understand this with an example.

Suppose the present Date and Time of a SATATYA NVR24P is set as:

17/02/2017, 16:13:10

Also, the recording of camera connected at channel 1 is ON.

In this case, when the time of the device is set as 16:10:10 which is before the present time, the device will start the recording from 16:10:10. To indicate this, 'Overlap' option appears before the camera of which the overlapping is happening. In this situation, the old recording of the camera will be overwritten by the device with the new recording.
